Over the past 14 years, Dr. Miller and his team, with the approval of the Board of Director's, have expanded our residential program to include 9 group homes. These homes support a multitude of unique individuals experiencing intellectual and developmental disabilities.

Dr. Miller also recognized that we needed to create unique and rewarding work opportunities for individuals. In January of 2006, through careful and thoughtful planning, Star of Hope purchased the Oregon Connection/House of Myrtlewood.

Star of Hope has over 165 employees, that is double what we had 10 years ago.

Dr. Mary O'Connor is a Professor in the Department of Zoology at the University of British Columbia. She received her PhD in 2008 from the University of North Carolina, Chapel Hill. Her research focuses on the role of biodiversity, temperature and climate change on ecosystem function particularly in eelgrass ecosystems. Additionally, she examines the effects of change in top predators and the influence of invasive species on marine habitats.
